

Procurement Act 2023

Updated 4th April 2024

As you are aware the Procurement Bill received Royal Assent on 26th October and is now the **Procurement Act 2023**.

In March 2024 the Procurement Regulations 2024 were laid in Parliament to bring some elements of the Bill and the wider regime into effect. This statutory instrument (SI), a form of secondary legislation, is [available to view](#).

The Government has launched the first official training product to support the introduction of the new Procurement Act: the Transforming Public Procurement Knowledge Drops.

The Knowledge Drops are designed to provide a high-level overview of the changes to the procurement regulations and are aimed at those who have regular interactions with procurement as well as suppliers including SMEs and VCSEs.
